Despite the ravages of death, war and death duties the house and the collection have remained relatively intact. Elton Hall is renowned for beautiful and interesting furniture, stunning portraits by Reynolds, Gainsborough and Constable and magnificent porcelain. The rooms in the house show the ever-evolving taste and fortunes of the family.

Arrive at Elton Hall by own transport. Parking is at Bosworth's Garden Centre, Elton PE8 6SH

The tour of the Hall will commence at **1pm**. Our guides will meet us in the car park. Please arrive by 12.50pm to allow time to gather.

A visit to the gardens will follow.
