## VISIT TO KING RICHARD III VISITOR CENTRE & CATHEDRAL, LEICESTER

## **TUESDAY 21st MAY 2024**

The King Richard III Visitor Centre explores the unbelievable historical detective story. It unfolds over two floors from the story of King Richard III and his rise and sudden dramatic fall from power to the research, archaeological dig and scientific analysis to confirm the remains as those of the King.

Don't miss the King's original grave site on the ground floor protected under a glass floor.

## **ITINERARY**

**09.00** Depart Danish Invader, Stamford. Please remember to put £2.00 in an envelope with your car registration and post through the Danish Invader letterbox at the back of the building.

Please be prompt to ensure a punctual arrival in Leicester.

10.15 (approx) Arrive at the King Richard III Visitor Centre, Leicester. We will be met by staff for a short walk to the Centre for coffee and biscuits followed by a talk of approximately one hour. This will take place on the top floor and an elevator is available.

12.00 We are then free to visit the exhibition (allow at least one hour as lots to see) have lunch in the Centre's White Boar Cafe or one of the many local cafes in the immediate area or visit the King's tomb in the Cathedral opposite the Centre.

Re-entry to the King Richard III Visitor Centre can be made at any time during the day.

Leicester City Centre, with its many shops, is within a short walk.

**15.30** Depart for Stamford, arriving at approximately **16.30 -1700** depending on traffic.
