The Terrace at Harewood House Credit Harewood House Trust



Nestled in the heart of Yorkshire, Harewood is one of the ten magnificent 'Treasure Houses of England'. This fine property was built in the 18th century, and the art collections on display here are some of the finest you will find in Britain. One hundred acres of grounds landscaped by 'Capability' Brown surround the property, offering a dynamic display of dazzling gardens.

# **Castle Howard**

The sublime Castle Howard has, for generations, been one of the great palaces of Europe. Stately and theatrical, the ornate house is filled with incredible antique sculptures and a vast array of arts; it is surrounded by extensive landscaped gardens and parkland. The icing on the cake is the vast estate's breathtaking location amongst the Howardian Hills, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

### **RHS Harlow Carr**

Lovely in every season, the RHS garden at Harlow Carr is a delight that sits in the glorious Yorkshire countryside. With woodland, water features and wildflowers over 68 acres, this is a relaxing and innovative garden to explore.

A splendid Jacobean house standing by the River Swale in the Vale of Mowbray, Kiplin Hall was the country seat of George Calvert,

1st Lord of Baltimore. The award-winning Hall is now shown as a comfortable Victorian home, with centuries of fascinating artefacts from previous owners. Beautifully crafted furniture from the 17th to 19th centuries, kitchenalia, family portraits and paintings make up the display whilst the stunning themed gardens surround the house.

#### **Tennants Auction House**

The largest auction house in the UK, a visit includes a two-course lunch, a talk from one of the resident experts and an opportunity to explore the extensive display galleries, showcasing highlights of upcoming auctions. Set over two floors, the Garden Rooms display an ever-changing array of fascinating art and antiques, from vintage and luxury watches and clocks, private collections of musical instruments to fashion, contemporary art, ceramics, and military uniforms.

#### Hepworth Wakefield

This modern purpose-built gallery is home to an impressive collection of modern British art including works by Barbara Hepworth (after whom the museum is named), LS Lowry and Henry Moore to name but a few. Major exhibitions are presented showcasing the best international modern and contemporary art, whilst outside, the garden designed by Tom Stuart-Smith is not to be missed.
